


FAIR WARNING

PILGRIM'S DANGEROUS PLAN:

- ◆ *Pilgrim Pipelines plans to run two pipes in one trench between Albany and Linden, NJ, along the NYS Thruway, to carry crude oil and refined fuels such as gasoline, jet fuel and kerosene.*
- ◆ *Pilgrim also plans to build lateral pipelines from the Thruway to the global storage facility on the Hudson, and another to the Roseton and Dannskammer power plants, through the towns of New Windsor & Newburgh.*
- ◆ *Pipelines spill far more oil than any other transport, such as trains, barges, or tanker trucks.*
- ◆ *The toxic and explosive oil can pollute water supplies and neighborhoods.*
- ◆ *To install – and maintain – their pipeline, Pilgrim needs easements on private property.*
- ◆ *They are offering money to homeowners for easements.*
- ◆ *The 'landman' will hand you a contract, filled in, and want you to sign.*



What to do?

We believe you should refuse the offer and tell the landmen to leave. This pipeline could destroy the value of your home and your neighborhood.



Consider these facts:

- ◆ The refined fuels and Bakken crude oil are very volatile and polluting.
- ◆ Pilgrim has no permits or approvals to start construction.
- ◆ The Pilgrim Pipeline project is opposed by almost 40 New Jersey and more than 20 New York municipalities, including the Town and City of Newburgh, Cornwall, New Windsor, and Cornwall-on-Hudson.
- ◆ It is opposed by citizen groups, including Orange RAPP and CAPP NY (Coalition Against Pilgrim Pipelines).

To oppose and stop the project is our best protection.

Consider these terms:

Pilgrim's easement agreement/contract includes these provisions:

- ◆ Pilgrim can transfer/assign the agreement to *any other company*.
- ◆ There are no limits to the number of pipelines that can be installed, nor to the other “above ground” industrial equipment, such as valves, meters, pumps.
- ◆ The company can change the location of the pipeline “pending certain developments.”
- ◆ The pipeline can be used to transport gas, oil, and “associated constituents” or for transporting “*other substances*, including water..”
- ◆ Pilgrim gives itself *3 years to pay homeowners* the specified money. Meanwhile, they can enforce the agreement - or just walk away.
