Pilgrim Pipeline Company is proposing to build a new, bi-directional pipeline to transport oil and refined petroleum products between Albany, New York and Linden, New Jersey. It would transport oil extracted from North Dakota's Bakken Shale via hydraulic fracturing, an extreme form extraction that pollutes our water and air and contributes to the climate crisis.
